Following months of hard work, Immingham's very own community cinema project will be launched this summer at Margaret Street's Imimage Studios. Funded by the BIG LOTTERY FUND, **One Voice** and the 'LEADER' Programme (see opposite) **Studio-1** will premier with Guy Ritchie's modern adaptation of the classic detective hero Sherlock Holmes on 15th July at 7.30pm. Seating is limited so arrive early - doors open at 7.00pm!



THERE'S ONE 'STUDIO-1'

Working in association with Imimage Studios and with the support of Humberside Police, Immingham Town Council and a number of business sponsors, **Studio-1** aims to bring a varied programme of material to the local community, ensuring that the medium of film is accessible and available to everyone in a local venue, providing an enjoyable, communal viewing experience.



Following the 'LEADER'

The **Studio-One** project has been supported by a £4750 grant through 'LEADER'. The money, part of a £2.4 million fund made available to rural groups in Northern Lincolnshire, will be used to buy screening and projection equipment

COMMUNITY PROJECTS GET GREEN LIGHT WITH SHARE OF £3000 PRIZE FUND!

Four community projects are set to benefit from a One Voice competition designed to encourage sustainable projects that help to improve the local environment.

The competition, introduced during the launch of Immingham's 'In Bloom' initiative gave residents, local schools, and community groups the opportunity to bid for up to £3,000 to help deliver projects addressing green issues such as recycling and conservation.

The funding will enable Immingham Schools, **Coomb Briggs Primary** and **Eastfield Primary** Schools to develop their respective 'Kitchen Garden' and 'Grow Your Own' projects, allowing children and parents to grow fruit and vegetables whilst encouraging social interaction.

Stallingborough CE Primary School's 'Community Lifestyle' project will see the planting of fruit trees and rearing of chickens, with produce being used in the school's cookery club.

Immingham's **Trinity Methodist Church** will be able to progress with their 'Outside Community Area' including enhancing the existing garden and the creation of a soft play area.
