# RESPECT

This REACH Passport is to help prepare you to become a citizen of the world upon graduation from Oasis Academy Immingham. By completing this passport, you will acquire new skills and train yourself to be disciplined and be the most excellent citizen for a 21<sup>st</sup> century society.

To gain the awards from this REACH Passport, you must provide evidence to your Form Tutor or subject teachers showing that you have completed one of the criteria. A collection of criteria means you can be awarded a Bronze, Silver or Gold award.

<b>Bronze REACH award</b>	You need to complete <b>THREE</b> criteria from each of the values <b>AND TWO</b> others of your choice.
<b>Silver REACH award</b>	You need to complete <b>FOUR</b> criteria from each of the values <b>AND THREE</b> others of your choice.
<b>Gold REACH award</b>	You need to complete <b>FIVE</b> criteria from each of the values <b>AND THREE</b> others of your choice.

<b>R 1</b>	Be a role model to other students (HoH to award)	
<b>R 2</b>	Always show respect towards other students and their beliefs (awarded by Form Tutor at the end of term)	
<b>R 3</b>	Be a librarian a day a week for a full term	
<b>R 4</b>	Send a postcard to a member of staff to say thank you for something or receive a respect postcard	
<b>R 5</b>	Be recognised by a teacher for performing an act of respect (picking up litter, holding the door open)	
<b>R 6</b>	To attend and be part of a respectful service / event (evidence required)
