

Oasis Academy Immingham Policy Statement on Provider Access

This policy statement sets out the Academy's arrangements for managing the access of providers to students at the Academy for the purpose of giving them impartial information about the providers, education and training on offer. This complies with the Academy's legal obligations under section 42B of the Education Act 1997.

Students in Y7-11 are entitled:

To find out about technical education qualifications and apprenticeship opportunities, as part of a careers programme which provides information on the full range of education and training options available at each transition point.

To access a range of local providers about the opportunities they offer, including technical education through: events, assemblies, lunchtime drop in sessions and taster events.

To understand how to make applications for the full range of academic and technical courses on offer through the Careers Leader/Advisor developing network connections.

Providers are welcome to leave a copy of their current prospectus or any other relevant course literature in the Careers Office. The office is regularly made available to students.


