LTP rationale:

Students learn the course content chronologically. This means they study the Greek elements of the Thematic Study and the Literature and Culture components, and then study the Roman elements.

The chronological approach gives students an overarching narrative of the period. More specifically, the rise of the Greek world and its conquest and continuation in the Roman world.

Moreover, students exercise recall to compare the Roman elements with the Greek, and act as revision of the Greek parts of each paper. They consider change and continuity between the two and understand how Roman culture and literature made allusions to Greek culture.
