Dear Parents/Carers,

Important Update – Tuesday 5th January

Further to my letter last week on the arrangements for the next couple of weeks, I am writing to you with an important update regarding tomorrow. All Oasis academies will be holding an additional INSET day on Tuesday 5th January, in addition to the one today.

I apologise for the late notice of this change but considering reports that the new variant of the coronavirus can travel between people more quickly, we wanted to ensure that we are doing all we can to keep everyone safe.

The controls we have had in place at the school since September have worked well to keep our school community safe, and tomorrow we will be revisiting each to ensure we remain fully compliant. Our Health and Safety Committee will be meeting, and as a staff team we will again go over the safety measures we have in place.

All schools within the Oasis Community Learning family will be using the day to double, treble check the precautions, and if possible, introduce additional safeguards. Please rest assured that this is not due to any concerns at the Academy about the measures we have in place, rather we are taking the time to go through everything methodically – as ever, everyone's health and safety is our priority.

What does this mean for my young person?

Students whose parents are key workers or who are determined by the DfE as 'vulnerable' are to attend school from Wednesday 6th January, not Tuesday 5th January as previously communicated. Please check the attached information provided for further guidance on this.

All other students are to access their lessons remotely from Wednesday 6th January. Students in an examination year (Year 11) will return to school in

All other students are required to return to school in person on Monday 18th January. **We do have some examinations on Monday 11th involving year 10's and 11's and we will be in contact prior to this but for your information the details of those examinations are as follows:**

Examinations: Monday 11th January 2021

9.00 am Sports Science (Year's 10 & 11) all of those students need to arrive at 8.30.

Currently it is planned for Year 11's to be in the academy from the 11th January but for information there is a Media examination at 12.45 pm for year 11 only.

If your child receives free school meals, but they are not eligible to come to school at this time, then they will be able to collect a hamper from Wednesday from the Academy – you will receive a text with further information about this.


Covid-19 testing within school
