Dear Parents & Carers of Year 8 and 9,

Further to my letter on Friday, due to staff absence we are asking Year 8 and Year 9 students to study from home tomorrow, Wednesday 1st December, and on Thursday 2nd December. We will update you regarding Friday 3rd December as soon as possible.

As I explained in my note last week, normal seasonal illnesses combined with some isolations around Covid-19 mean that we do not currently have the required number of staff available. Unfortunately, we are not yet able to be able to welcome the students back tomorrow or on Thursday.

I will be in touch again later this week once the situation is clearer on whether we will be able to open fully on Friday. As always, our priority is to inform you as soon as we can so that you can make arrangements.


As a reminder, we are only asking your child to learn from home because we do not currently have enough staff to have them at the Academy, they are not being asked to self-isolate.
